PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how we handle personal data collected through the website <https://aurra.ink> (the “Site”).

It covers the Site only. It does not cover the payment platform you reach after signing in — that platform is operated by Nota Inc., which handles your data as a separate, independent controller under its own privacy policy. See Section 6.

1. WHO WE ARE

The controller of personal data collected through the Site is:

We are not required to appoint a data protection officer. Privacy questions should be sent to the address above.

2. WHAT WE COLLECT

Information you give us. Name, business email address, phone number, job title, company name, country and any message content you submit through a contact form, callback request, demo request or newsletter subscription.

Most of our users are businesses. Where you contact us on behalf of a company, the data you give us about yourself and about your colleagues or authorised representatives is still personal data, and this Policy applies to it.

Information collected automatically. IP address, browser and device type, operating system, language, referring page, pages viewed and time of visit. This is collected through server logs and, where you consent, through analytics cookies.

Information we receive in return. Where we have passed an enquiry on, we may receive limited confirmation that it resulted in a registration. This is confined to a reference identifier and a date. We do not receive identity documents, verification results, balances, transactions or account activity, and we do not ask for them.

We do not collect identity documents, financial data, payment details or transaction data through the Site. That information is collected by Nota, not by us.

3. WHY WE USE IT, AND ON WHAT LEGAL BASIS

We do not use your data for automated decision-making or profiling that produces legal effects for you.

4. COOKIES

We use strictly necessary cookies, which are required for the Site to work and do not need your consent, and analytics cookies, which we set only if you accept them in the cookie banner.

You can change or withdraw your cookie choices at any time through the banner or your browser settings. Details are set out in our Cookie Policy.

5. WHO WE SHARE IT WITH

We do not sell your personal data and we do not share it for third-party advertising.

We share it only with:

- **Nota Inc.**, where you choose to proceed to the platform, or where you have asked us to pass your enquiry to it (see Section 6);
- **service providers acting on our instructions** — website hosting, email delivery, analytics, customer support and IT security tools, each bound by a data processing agreement;
- **authorities, courts and advisers**, where we are legally required to disclose or where necessary to establish or defend legal claims;
- **an acquirer or successor**, in connection with a merger, reorganisation or sale of our business, subject to the protections in this Policy continuing to apply.

6. WHEN YOU MOVE TO THE NOTA PLATFORM

When you select “Sign in,” “Sign up” or an equivalent action and proceed to the payment platform, your data is collected and processed by:

Nota acts as an **independent controller**, not as our processor, and we are not joint controllers. Nota decides why and how it processes your data, including for identity verification, sanctions screening and anti-money-laundering compliance, and it is subject to its own legal obligations under Canadian law. For business customers this includes know-your-business checks, and data about directors, authorised representatives and ultimate beneficial owners. Data about the counterparties you pay is likewise provided to Nota, not to us.

This applies even where the interface still shows Aurra branding or an aurra.ink address.

Requests concerning data held on the Platform must be addressed to Nota. Please review Nota’s privacy policy before providing your data to it.

7. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

We operate internationally, and some of our service providers may be located in other countries.

Where we transfer data to a provider in a country without a comparable recognised standard, we put contractual safeguards in place before doing so. You can request details of the safeguards that apply by writing to info@aurra.ink.

8. HOW LONG WE KEEP IT

We keep personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes described in this Policy, and for any longer period required by applicable law.

When retention is no longer required, we securely delete or anonymise the data.

9. YOUR RIGHTS

We operate internationally and apply a single consistent standard to all users, wherever they are located. Our reference frameworks include Canadian federal privacy law (the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act), the data protection laws of the United States and its states, the General Data Protection Regulation, and the laws of any other jurisdiction applicable to a given user.

Depending on where you are located, you have the right to: access your data; have it corrected; have it erased; restrict or object to its processing; receive it in a portable

format; and withdraw consent at any time, without affecting processing carried out before withdrawal. We apply these rights to all users, wherever they are based.

To exercise any of these rights, write to **info@aurra.ink**. We will respond within one month. We may ask you to confirm your identity first.

You can unsubscribe from marketing at any time using the link in any email.

If you are unhappy with how we have handled your data, you may also complain to the data protection authority competent for you — either the authority in your own country, or the authority competent for the jurisdiction in which we are established. We will provide its contact details on request to info@aurra.ink.

10. SECURITY AND CHILDREN

We use appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your data, including encryption in transit and restricted access. No online transmission is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

The Site is not directed at anyone under 18, and we do not knowingly collect data from children. If you believe a child has provided us with data, write to info@aurra.ink and we will delete it.

11. CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

We may update this Policy. The current version is always published at <https://aurra.ink/legal> with the date above. If a change materially affects you, we will notify you on the Site and, where we have your email address, by email at least 30 days before it takes effect.
